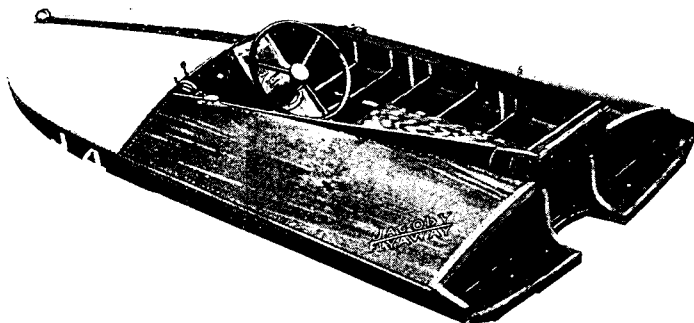

Its extreme new low sides and advanced stream-lined deck cut down wind resistance and, with perfect balance, insure record breaking speed.

New 1934 features: New Bottom design, New Steerer, New Floor with Stirrups also removable for washing, Stringers, Reinforced Transom, Reinforced Fin Block, Reinforced Coaming, Steam-bent Chines, salt water Fastening, Copper Riveted, Air-plane linen deck finished with five coats of Wing Dope.

Equipment.

Aluminum Fin for Class M, A and B. Bronze Fin for Class C, F and X mounted. Flyaway lifting handle, Copper Stem Band.

Special Racing Steerer, Bronze Remote control and Bowdoin Cable mounted on Coaming port side.

Bronze inserted steering Rope one-quarter inch and five-sixteenths inch, and steering pulleys mounted.

Flyaway Motor Socket.

Two Eye Bolts in deck, two metal coaming straps.

Bow line.

Additional racing equipment including cushions, boat cover, cockpit and overall covers, puddles, fire extinguishers, life jackets, other accessories and safety devices may be purchased from Service Department of the Fred Jacoby Boat Works.

Special paint job \$10.00 extra.

Special lettering and racing numbers on new boats will be at the rate of ten cents per letter or numeral.

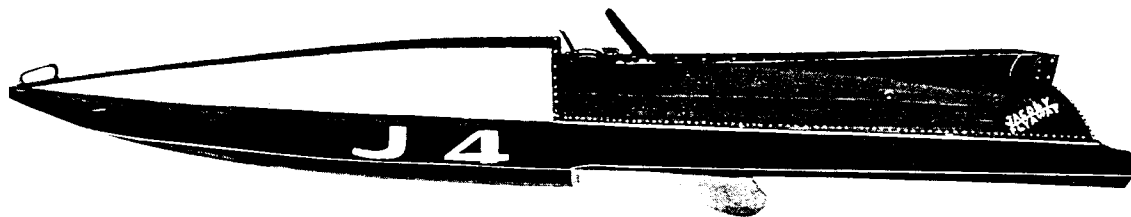
